GIVE TO THE CHILDREN'S HOME



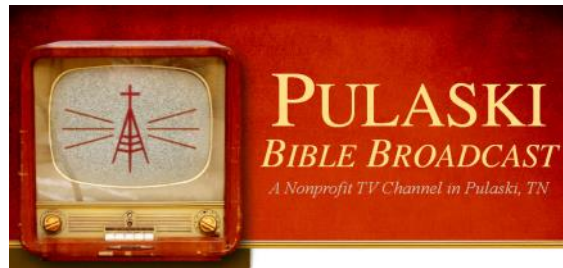
The truck for the Tennessee Children's Food Home will be here on September 26th to pick up the donated supplies. Please have your supplies here early and if possible make a donation.

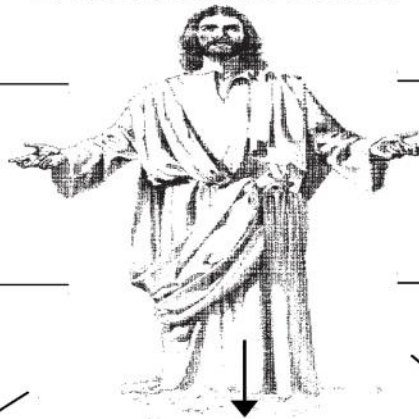

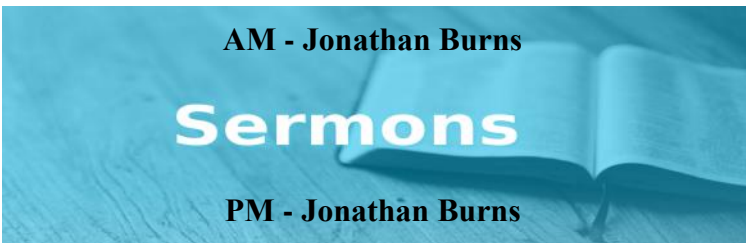
